**AN ACT**

For the relief of Nuratu Olarewaju Abeke Kadiri.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR NURATU**

4                                **OLAREWAJU ABEKE KADIRI.**

5            (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)  
6        and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality  
7        Act, Nuratu Olarewaju Abeke Kadiri shall be eligible for  
8        issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status  
9        to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent resi-  
10        dence upon filing an application for issuance of an immi-

1 grant visa under section 204 of such Act or for adjustment  
2 of status to lawful permanent resident.

3 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Nuratu Olarewaju  
4 Abeke Kadiri enters the United States before the filing  
5 deadline specified in subsection (c), she shall be considered  
6 to have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if other-  
7 wise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status under  
8 section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of  
9 the date of the enactment of this Act.

10 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF  
11 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-  
12 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-  
13 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees  
14 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

15 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—  
16 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-  
17 idence to Nuratu Olarewaju Abeke Kadiri, the Secretary  
18 of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1,  
19 during the current or next following fiscal year, the total  
20 number of immigrant visas that are made available to na-  
21 tives of the country of the alien's birth under section  
22 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act or, if appli-  
23 cable, the total number of immigrant visas that are made  
24 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth  
25 under section 202(e) of such Act.

1       (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION  
2 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural  
3 parents, brothers, and sisters of Nuratu Olarewaju Abeke  
4 Kadiri shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be ac-  
5 corded any right, privilege, or status under the Immigra-  
6 tion and Nationality Act.
