## A BILL

To provide that compliance by States with the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 shall be voluntary.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. VOLUNTARY COMPLIANCE BY STATES WITH NA-**  
4 **TIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION ACT OF 1993.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The National Voter Registration  
6 Act of 1993 (42 U.S.C. 1973gg et seq.) is amended—

7 (1) by redesignating section 13 as section 14;  
8 and

9 (2) by inserting after section 12 the following  
10 new section:

1 **“SEC. 13. VOLUNTARY COMPLIANCE BY STATES.**

2 “Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act,  
3 compliance by a State with any provision of this Act shall  
4 be voluntary.”.

5 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
6 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-  
7 ment of this Act.
