1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

2 The Federal building and United States courthouse
3 located at 251 North Main Street in Winston-Salem,
4 North Carolina, shall be known and designated as the
5 “Hiram H. Ward Federal Building and United States
6 Courthouse”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
10 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
11 a reference to the “Hiram H. Ward Federal Building and
12 United States Courthouse”.
