## AN ACT

To rename the Washington National Airport located in the District of Columbia and Virginia as the “Ronald Reagan National Airport”.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

2 The airport described in the Act entitled “An Act to  
3 provide for the administration of the Washington National  
4 Airport, and for other purposes”, approved June 29, 1940  
5 (Chapter 444; 54 Stat. 686), and known as the Washing-  
6 ton National Airport, shall hereafter be known and des-  
7 ignated as the “Ronald Reagan National Airport”.

8 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—(1) The following provisions of  
10 law are amended by striking “Washington National Air-  
11 port” each place it appears and inserting “Ronald Reagan  
12 National Airport”:

13 (A) Section 1(b) of the Act of June 29, 1940  
14 (Chapter 444; 54 Stat. 686).

15 (B) Sections 106 and 107 of the Act of October  
16 31, 1945 (Chapter 443; 59 Stat. 553).

17 (C) Section 41714 of title 49, United States  
18 Code.

19 (D) Chapter 491 of title 49, United States  
20 Code.

21 (2) Section 41714(d) of title 49, United States Code,  
22 is amended in the subsection heading by striking “WASH-  
23 INGTON NATIONAL AIRPORT” and inserting “RONALD  
24 REAGAN NATIONAL AIRPORT”.

25 (b) OTHER REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law,  
26 map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the

1 United States to the Washington National Airport shall  
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Ronald Reagan Na-  
3 tional Airport”.
