3 That section 404(f)(1)(B) of the Federal Water Pollution

4 Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1344(f)(1)(B)) is amended—

5 (1) by striking “and” before “bridge”;

6 (2) by inserting before the semicolon at the end

7 the following: “, and maintenance and repair re-

1 quired to operate and maintain the serviceability of
2 partially vegetated flood control channels that are
3 components of flood control projects”.
