A BILL

To authorize and direct the Director of the Office of Management and Budget to reduce nondefense discretionary spending limits by two percentage points for each of fiscal years 1999 through 2002.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That, upon the enactment of this Act, the Director of the
4 Office of Management and Budget shall—

5 (1) reduce the adjusted discretionary spending
6 limits for the nondefense category set forth in sec-
7 tion 251(c) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency

1 Deficit Control Act of 1985 by two percentage
2 points for each of fiscal years 1999 and 2000; and
3 (2) reduce the adjusted discretionary spending
4 limits for the discretionary category set forth in such
5 section 251(c) by two percentage points for each of
6 fiscal years 2001 and 2002.
