A BILL

To amend the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 to expand the School Breakfast Program in elementary schools, and to provide greater access to snacks in school-based childcare programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SHORT TITLE

4 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the “Meals for
5 Achievement Act”.

1 EXPANSION OF SCHOOL BREAKFAST PROGRAM

2 SEC. 2. Section 4(b)(1)(B) of the Child Nutrition Act
3 of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1773(b)(1)(B) is amended—

4 (1) in the first sentence, by striking “for each
5 free breakfast” and inserting “for each breakfast
6 served in an elementary school and each free break-
7 fast served in a school other than an elementary
8 school”;

9 (2) in the second sentence, by inserting “served
10 in a school other than an elementary school” after
11 “reduced price breakfast”; and

12 (3) in the third sentence, by inserting “in a
13 school other than an elementary school” after
14 “served”.

15 SEC. 3. Section 17A of the National School Lunch
16 Act (42 U.S.C. 1766a) is amended—

17 (1) In paragraph (a)(2)—

18 (A) by adding “and” at the end of sub-
19 paragraph (A);

20 (B) by striking “; and” at the end of sub-
21 paragraph (B) and inserting a period; and

22 (C) by striking subparagraph (C);

23 (2) by striking subsection (b); and

- 1 (3) by redesignating subsections (c) and (d) as
- 2 (b) and (e).
