Mr. TRAFICANT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence

A BILL

To recognize and compensate Boris Korczak for intelligence gathering services rendered during the cold war.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FINDINGS.**

4 Congress finds the following:

5 (1) Boris Korczak is a resident alien of the
6 United States currently residing at 10392 Willa Mae
7 Court, Fairfax, Virginia.

8 (2) From 1973 to 1980, while living in Copen-
9 hagen, Denmark, Boris Korczak collected intel-

1 ligence information for the United States Govern-
2 ment.

3 (3) Boris Korczak volunteered his services to
4 the United States, and during the time that he gath-
5 ered intelligence for the Central Intelligence Agency
6 he was compensated only for his expenses.

7 (4) Boris Korczak provided valuable intelligence
8 information and services to the United States.

9 (5) Boris Korczak provided such services at
10 great personal risk to himself and his family.

11 (6) Boris Korczak should be compensated for
12 his service to the United States and for the enor-
13 mous personal risk he and his family incurred over
14 an extended period of time.

15 **SEC. 2. PAYMENT.**

16 The Director of the Central Intelligence Agency shall
17 pay out of funds available to the Director the sum of
18 \$225,000 to Mr. Boris Korczak of 10392 Willa Mae
19 Court, Fairfax, Virginia.

20 **SEC. 3. LIMITATION.**

21 No amount exceeding 10 percent of the payment
22 made under section 2 may be paid to or received by any
23 attorney or agent for services rendered in connection with
24 the payment. Any person who violates this section shall
25 be guilty of an infraction and shall be subject to a fine

1 in the amount provided under title 18, United States
2 Code.
