A BILL

To amend chapter 51 of title 31, United States Code, to allow the Secretary of the Treasury greater discretion with regard to the placement of the required inscriptions on quarter dollars issued under the 50 States Commemorative Coin Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 5112(l)(1) of title 31, United States Code,

4 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-

5 paragraph:

6 “(C) FLEXIBILITY WITH REGARD TO

7 PLACEMENT OF INSCRIPTIONS.—Notwithstand-

1 ing subsection (d)(1), the Secretary may select
2 a design for quarter dollars issued during the
3 10-year period referred to in subparagraph (A)
4 in which—

5 “(i) the inscription described in the 2d
6 sentence of subsection (d)(1) appears on
7 the reverse side of any such quarter dol-
8 lars; and

9 “(ii) any inscription described in the
10 3d sentence of subsection (d)(1) or the
11 designation of the value of the coin ap-
12 pears on the obverse side of any such quar-
13 ter dollars.”.
