## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain printing  
machinery.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CER-**  
4       **TAIN PRINTING MACHINERY.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8 new heading:

“	9902.84.43	Ink-jet textile printing machin- ery (provided for in subheading 8443.51.10) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/99	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall apply to goods entered, or withdrawn  
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the date that  
4 is 15 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.

5 (c) RETROACTIVE APPLICATION.—Notwithstanding  
6 section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 or any other provi-  
7 sion of law, upon proper request filed with the Customs  
8 Service within 180 days after the date of the enactment  
9 of this Act, any entry, or withdrawal from warehouse for  
10 consumption, of goods described in subheading  
11 8443.51.10 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the  
12 United States—

13 (1) which was made after December 31, 1997,  
14 and before the date that is 15 days after the date  
15 of the enactment of this Act, and

16 (2) with respect to which there would have been  
17 no duty if the amendment made by subsection (a)  
18 applied to such entry or withdrawal,  
19 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as if such amendment  
20 applied to such entry or withdrawal.
