Mr. HASTINGS of Washington introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To adjust the boundaries of the Lake Chelan National Recreation Area and the adjacent Wenatchee National Forest in the State of Washington.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS, LAKE CHELAN NA-**
4 **TIONAL RECREATION AREA AND WENATCHEE**
5 **NATIONAL FOREST, WASHINGTON.**

6 (a) BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS.—

7 (1) LAKE CHELAN NATIONAL RECREATION
8 AREA.—The boundary of the Lake Chelan National
9 Recreation Area, established by section 202 of Pub-
10 lic Law 90–544 (16 U.S.C. 90a–1), is hereby ad-

1 justed to exclude a parcel of land and waters con-
2 sisting of approximately 88 acres, as depicted on the
3 map entitled “Proposed Management Units, North
4 Cascades, Washington”, numbered NP–CAS–7002A,
5 originally dated October 1967, and revised July 13,
6 1994.

7 (2) WENATCHEE NATIONAL FOREST.—The
8 boundary of the Wenatchee National Forest is here-
9 by adjusted to include the parcel of land and waters
10 described in paragraph (1).

11 (3) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The map referred
12 to in paragraph (1) shall be on file and available for
13 public inspection in the offices of the superintendent
14 of the Lake Chelan National Recreation Area and
15 the Director of the National Park Service, Depart-
16 ment of the Interior, and in the office of the Chief
17 of the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture.

18 (b) TRANSFER OF ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDIC-
19 TION.—Administrative jurisdiction over Federal land and
20 waters in the parcel covered by the boundary adjustments
21 in subsection (a) is transferred from the Secretary of the
22 Interior to the Secretary of Agriculture, and the trans-
23 ferred land and waters shall be managed by the Secretary
24 of Agriculture in accordance with the laws and regulations
25 pertaining to the National Forest System.

1 (c) LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND.—For
2 purposes of section 7 of the Land and Water Conservation
3 Fund Act of 1965 (16 U.S.C. 4601–9), the boundaries of
4 the Wenatchee National Forest, as adjusted by subsection
5 (a), shall be considered to be the boundaries of the
6 Wenatchee National Forest as of January 1, 1965.
