## A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of the Army Reserve Center in Jamestown, Ohio, to benefit the Greeneview Local School District of Jamestown, Ohio.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, ARMY RESERVE CENTER,**  
4                               **JAMESTOWN, OHIO.**

5       (a) CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of  
6 the Army may convey, without consideration, to the  
7 Greeneview Local School District of Jamestown, Ohio, all  
8 right, title, and interest of the United States in and to  
9 a parcel of excess Federal real property, including im-  
10 provements thereon, that is located at 5693 Plymouth

1 Road in Jamestown, Ohio, and contains an Army Reserve  
2 Center.

3 (b) PURPOSE OF CONVEYANCE.—The purpose of the  
4 conveyance under subsection (a) is to permit the  
5 Greeneview Local School District to retain and use the  
6 conveyed property for the benefit of the students of  
7 Greeneview schools.

8 (c) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage  
9 and legal description of the real property to be conveyed  
10 under subsection (a) shall be determined by a survey satis-  
11 factory to the Secretary. The cost of such survey shall be  
12 borne by the Greeneview Local School District.

13 (d) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The  
14 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-  
15 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection  
16 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the  
17 interests of the United States.
