3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Blackstone River Val-
5 ley Heritage Corridor Technical Corrections Act of 1998”.

1 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF BLACKSTONE RIVER VAL-**
2 **LEY NATIONAL HERITAGE CORRIDOR**
3 **PROJECT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.**

4 (a) REAUTHORIZATION.—Section 10(b) of the Act
5 entitled “An Act to establish the Blackstone River Valley
6 National Heritage Corridor in Massachusetts and Rhode
7 Island”, approved November 10, 1986 (Public Law 99–
8 647; 16 U.S.C. 461 note), is amended by striking “For
9 fiscal years 1996, 1997, and 1998,” and inserting “For
10 fiscal years 1998, 1999, and 2000,”.

11 (b) TECHNICAL CORRECTION.—Such Act is further
12 amended in section 6(d)(2), by striking “may be made in
13 the approval plan” and inserting “may be made in the
14 approved plan”.
