1 **SECTION 1. REQUIRING NATIONAL COMMITTEES OF POLIT-**
2 **ICAL PARTIES TO FILE CERTAIN PRE-GEN-**
3 **ERAL ELECTION REPORTS.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 304(a)(4)(A)(ii) of the
5 Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C.
6 434(a)(4)(A)(ii)) is amended by striking “such election,”
7 and inserting the following: “such election (together with,
8 in the case of a national committee of a political party,
9 any other general election),”.

10 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
11 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to elections occur-
12 ring after January 1997.
