3 **SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF LACK OF AUTHORITY TO**
4 **COLLECT FEES FOR NAVIGATIONAL ASSIST-**
5 **ANCE SERVICES.**

6 Section 2110(a)(5) of title 46, United States Code,
7 is amended—

1 (1) by inserting “or any other authority” after
2 “subsection”; and

3 (2) by inserting “or for any navigational assist-
4 ance service, including icebreaking” after “search or
5 rescue service”.
