## AN ACT

For the relief of Heraclio Tolley.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. IMMEDIATE RELATIVE STATUS FOR HERACLIO**  
2 **TOLLEY.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heraclio Tolley shall be classified  
4 as a child under section 101(b)(1)(E) of the Immigration  
5 and Nationality Act for purposes of approval of a relative  
6 visa petition filed under section 204 of such Act by his  
7 adoptive parent and the filing of an application for an im-  
8 migrant visa or adjustment of status.

9 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Heraclio Tolley  
10 enters the United States before the filing deadline speci-  
11 fied in subsection (c), he shall be considered to have en-  
12 tered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible,  
13 be eligible for adjustment of status under section 245 of  
14 the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of the  
15 enactment of this Act.

16 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF  
17 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the pe-  
18 tition and the application for issuance of an immigrant  
19 visa or the application for adjustment of status are filed  
20 with appropriate fees within 2 years after the date of the  
21 enactment of this Act.

22 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—  
23 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-  
24 idence to Heraclio Tolley, the Secretary of State shall in-  
25 struct the proper officer to reduce by 1, for the current  
26 or next following fiscal year, the worldwide level of family-

1 sponsored immigrants under section 201(c)(1)(A) of the  
2 Immigration and Nationality Act.

3 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION  
4 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural  
5 parents, brothers, and sisters of Heraclio Tolley shall not,  
6 by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right, privi-  
7 lege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
