A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to participate in the design, planning, and construction of the Willow Lake Natural Treatment System Project for the reclamation and reuse of water, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WILLOW LAKE NATURAL TREATMENT SYSTEM**
4 **PROJECT.**

5 The Reclamation Wastewater and Groundwater
6 Studies and Facilities Act (43 U.S.C. 390h et seq.) is
7 amended by adding at the end the following:

1 **“SEC. 1618. WILLOW LAKE NATURAL TREATMENT SYSTEM**
2 **PROJECT.**

3 “(a) **AUTHORIZATION.**—The Secretary, in coopera-
4 tion with the city of Salem, Oregon, is authorized to par-
5 ticipate in the design, planning, and construction of the
6 Willow Lake Natural Treatment System Project to re-
7 claim and reuse wastewater within and without the service
8 area of the city of Salem.

9 “(b) **COST SHARE.**—The Federal share of the cost
10 of the project authorized by this section shall not exceed
11 25 percent of the total cost of the project.

12 “(c) **LIMITATION.**—The Secretary shall not provide
13 funds for the operation and maintenance of the project
14 authorized by this section.”.
