3 **SECTION 1. THOMAS P. FOGLIETTA POST OFFICE BUILD-**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The United States Postal Serv-  
6 ice building located at 400 Edgmont Avenue, in Chester,  
7 Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated as the  
8 “Thomas P. Foglietta Post Office Building”.

1           (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
3 States to the building referred to in subsection (a) shall  
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “Thomas P. Foglietta  
5 Post Office Building”.
