A BILL

To restore veterans tobacco-related benefits as in effect before the enactment of the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RESTORATION OF VETERANS TOBACCO-RELAT-**
4 **ED BENEFITS.**

5 (a) REPEAL.—Section 1103 of title 38, United States
6 Code, is repealed.

1 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
2 at the beginning of chapter 11 of such title is amended
3 by striking the item relating to section 1103.

4 **SEC. 2. FUNDS NOT REQUIRED TO BE OFFSET FROM OTHER**
5 **PROGRAMS.**

6 Upon the enactment of this Act, the Director of the
7 Office of Management and Budget shall not make any es-
8 timate of changes in direct spending outlays under section
9 252(d) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit
10 Control Act of 1985 for any fiscal year resulting from the
11 enactment of this Act.
