## A BILL

To repeal the provision of law under which pay for Members  
of Congress is automatically adjusted

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Paragraph (2) of section 601(a)  
5 of the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C.  
6 31) is repealed.

7 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section 601(a)(1)  
8 of such Act is amended—

9 (1) by striking “(a)(1)” and inserting “(a)”;

1           (2) by redesignating subparagraphs (A), (B),  
2           and (C) as paragraphs (1), (2), and (3), respectively;

3           and

4           (3) by striking “, as adjusted by paragraph (2)  
5           of this subsection”.
