3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-
5 cated at 7748 South Cottage Grove Avenue in Chicago,
6 Illinois, is hereby designated as the “John H. Sengstacke
7 Post Office Building”. Any reference to such facility in
8 a law, regulation, map, document, paper, or other record

1 of the United States shall be considered to be a reference
2 to the “John H. Sengstacke Post Office Building”.
