A BILL

To permit the waiver of District of Columbia residency requirements for certain employees of the Office of the Inspector General of the District of Columbia, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “District of Columbia
3 Inspector General Improvement Act of 1997”.

4 **SEC. 2. WAIVER OF RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR CER-**
5 **TAIN EMPLOYEES OF INSPECTOR GENERAL.**

6 Section 906 of the District of Columbia Government
7 Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978 (sec. 1–
8 610.6, D.C. Code) is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a), by inserting “or sub-
10 section (d)” after “subsection (c)”; and

11 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
12 section:

13 “(d) At the request of the Inspector General (as de-
14 scribed in section 208(a) of the District of Columbia Pro-
15 curement Practices Act of 1985), the Director of Person-
16 nel may waive the application of subsections (a) and (b)
17 to employees of the Office of the Inspector General.”.

18 **SEC. 3. PERMITTING WAIVER OF REDUCTION IN ANNUITY**
19 **FOR FEDERAL ANNUITANTS EMPLOYED BY**
20 **CERTAIN DISTRICT OFFICES.**

21 (a) ~~RETIRED MEMBERS OF UNIFORMED SERVICE.—~~
22 Section ~~5532(j)~~ of title 5, United States Code, is amended
23 by striking the period at the end and inserting “; but shall
24 include the Office of the Inspector General of the District
25 of Columbia and the Office of the Chief Financial Officer

1 of the District of Columbia during the 4-year period which
2 begins April 17, 1995.”.

3 (b) RETIRED ANNUITANTS UNDER CIVIL SERVICE
4 RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—Section 8344(1)(1) of title 5,
5 United States Code, is amended by striking the period at
6 the end and inserting “, but shall include the Office of
7 the Inspector General of the District of Columbia and the
8 Office of the Chief Financial Officer of the District of Co-
9 lumbia during the 4-year period which begins April 17,
10 1995.”.

11 (c) RETIRED ANNUITANTS UNDER FEDERAL EM-
12 PLOYEES’ RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—Section 8468(i)(1) of
13 title 5, United States Code, is amended by striking the
14 period at the end and inserting “, but shall include the
15 Office of the Inspector General of the District of Columbia
16 and the Office of the Chief Financial Officer of the Dis-
17 trict of Columbia during the 4-year period which begins
18 April 17, 1995.”.

19 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
20 this section shall apply with respect to annuities paid
21 under title 5, United States Code, for months beginning
22 with May 1996.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to permit the waiver of District of Columbia residency requirements for certain employees of the Office of the Inspector General of the District of Columbia.”.
