A BILL

To provide for the expansion of the Eagles Nest Wilderness within Arapaho and White River National Forests, Colorado, to include the lands known as the Slate Creek Addition upon the acquisition of the lands by the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SLATE CREEK ADDITION TO EAGLES NEST WIL-**
4 **DERNESS, ARAPAHO AND WHITE RIVER NA-**
5 **TIONAL FORESTS, COLORADO.**

6 (a) SLATE CREEK ADDITION.—If, before December
7 31, 2000, the United States acquires the parcel of land

1 described in subsection (b), then, upon the acquisition of
2 the parcel by the United States, the parcel shall be in-
3 cluded in, and managed as part of, the Eagles Nest Wil-
4 derness designated by Public Law 94–352 (90 Stat. 870;
5 16 U.S.C. 1132 note). The Secretary of Agriculture shall
6 adjust the boundaries of the Eagles Nest Wilderness to
7 reflect the inclusion of the parcel.

8 (b) DESCRIPTION OF ADDITION.—The parcel re-
9 ferred to in subsection (a) is generally depicted on a map
10 entitled ‘Slate Creek Addition-Eagles Nest Wilderness’,
11 dated February 1997, and comprises approximately 160
12 acres in Summit County, Colorado, adjacent to the Eagles
13 Nest Wilderness.
