2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SLATE CREEK ADDITION TO EAGLES NEST WIL-**
4 **DERNESS, ARAPAHO AND WHITE RIVER NA-**
5 **TIONAL FORESTS, COLORADO.**

6 (a) *SLATE CREEK ADDITION.*—*If the parcel of land*
7 *described in subsection (b) is conveyed to the United States*
8 *on or before December 31, 2000, the parcel shall be included*
9 *in, and managed as part of, the Eagles Nest Wilderness des-*
10 *ignated by Public Law 94–352 (90 Stat. 870; 16 U.S.C.*
11 *1132 note). Upon conveyance of the parcel, the boundary*
12 *of the Eagles Nest Wilderness is adjusted to include the par-*
13 *cel.*

14 (b) *DESCRIPTION OF ADDITION.*—*The parcel referred*
15 *to in subsection (a) is generally depicted on a map entitled*
16 *“Slate Creek Addition-Eagles Nest Wilderness”, dated Feb-*
17 *ruary 1997, which shall be available for public inspection*
18 *in the office of the Forest Supervisor of the White River*
19 *National Forest in the State of Colorado. The parcel com-*
20 *prises approximately 160 acres in Summit County, Colo-*
21 *rado, adjacent to the Eagles Nest Wilderness.*
