Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1273) to authorize appropriations for fiscal years 1998 and 1999 for the National Science Foundation, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1273) to authorize appropriations
6 for fiscal years 1998 and 1999 for the National Science

1 Foundation, and for other purposes. The first reading of
2 the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be
3 confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally
4 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
5 nority member of the Committee on Science. After general
6 debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under
7 the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as
8 an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the
9 five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
10 stitute recommended by the Committee on Science now
11 printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the na-
12 ture of a substitute shall be considered by title rather than
13 by section. Each title shall be considered as read. During
14 consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of
15 the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in rec-
16 ognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an
17 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of
18 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
19 clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be
20 considered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of
21 the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and re-
22 port the bill to the House with such amendments as may
23 have been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate
24 vote in the House on any amendment adopted in the Com-
25 mittee of the Whole to the bill or to the committee amend-

1 ment in the nature of a substitute. The previous question
2 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
3 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
4 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
