Mr. MCINNIS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1275) to authorize appropriations for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration for fiscal years 1998 and 1999, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1275) to authorize appropriations
6 for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration

1 for fiscal years 1998 and 1999, and for other purposes.
2 The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points
3 of order against consideration of the bill for failure to com-
4 ply with clause 2(1)(6) of rule XI are waived. General de-
5 bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one
6 hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
7 ranking minority member of the Committee on Science.
8 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
9 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order
10 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-
11 ment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the na-
12 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
13 Science now printed in the bill. The committee amendment
14 in the nature of a substitute shall be considered by title
15 rather than by section. Each title shall be considered as
16 read. During consideration of the bill for amendment, the
17 Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may accord pri-
18 ority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member
19 offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the
20 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that
21 purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed
22 shall be considered as read. At the conclusion of consider-
23 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
24 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
25 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a

1 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
2 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the commit-
3 tee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The previous
4 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
5 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
6 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
7 structions.
