## RESOLUTION

Waiving a requirement of clause 4(b) of rule XI with respect to consideration of certain resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules.

1       *Resolved*, That the requirement of clause 4(b) of rule  
2 XI for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the  
3 Committee on Rules on the same day it is presented to  
4 the House is waived with respect to any resolution re-  
5 ported before May 23, 1997, providing for consideration  
6 or disposition of any of the following measures:

1           (1) A concurrent resolution on the budget, an  
2           amendment thereto, a conference report thereon, or  
3           an amendment reported in disagreement from a con-  
4           ference thereon.

5           (2) The bill (H.R. 1469) making emergency  
6           supplemental appropriations for recovery from natu-  
7           ral disasters, and for overseas peacekeeping efforts,  
8           including those in Bosnia, for the fiscal year ending  
9           September 30, 1997, and for other purposes, an  
10          amendment thereto, a conference report thereon, or  
11          an amendment reported in disagreement from a con-  
12          ference thereon.
