## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 54) proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States authorizing the Congress to prohibit the physical desecration of the flag of the United States.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the joint reso-  
3 lution (H.J. Res. 54) proposing an amendment to the Con-  
4 stitution of the United States authorizing the Congress  
5 to prohibit the physical desecration of the flag of the Unit-

1 ed States. The joint resolution shall be considered as read  
2 for amendment. The joint resolution shall be debatable for  
3 two hours equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
4 and ranking minority member of the Committee on the  
5 Judiciary. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
6 dered on the joint resolution to final passage without in-  
7 tervening motion except one motion to recommit. The mo-  
8 tion to recommit may include instructions only if offered  
9 by the minority leader or his designee. If including instruc-  
10 tions, the motion to recommit shall be debatable for one  
11 hour equally divided and controlled by the proponent and  
12 an opponent.
