Mr. GOSS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

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## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1775) to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 1998 for intelligence and intelligence-related activities of the United States Government, the Community Management Account, and the Central Intelligence Retirement and Disability System, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 1775) to authorize appropriations  
3 for fiscal year 1998 for intelligence and intelligence-relat-  
4 ed activities of the United States Government, the Com-  
5 munity Management Account, and the Central Intelligence  
6 Agency Retirement and Disability System, and for other  
7 purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed  
8 with. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall  
9 not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the  
10 chairman and ranking minority member of the Permanent  
11 Select Committee on Intelligence. After general debate the  
12 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-  
13 minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original  
14 bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute  
15 rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-  
16 ommended by the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-  
17 ligence now printed in the bill. The committee amendment  
18 in the nature of a substitute shall be considered by title  
19 rather than by section. Each title shall be considered as  
20 read. Points of order against the committee amendment  
21 in the nature of a substitute for failure to comply with  
22 clause 7 of rule XVI or clause 5(a) or clause 5(b) of rule  
23 XXI are waived. No amendments to the committee amend-  
24 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order unless  
25 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-

1 ignated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. At  
2 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment  
3 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House  
4 with such amendments as may have been adopted. Any  
5 Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any  
6 amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the  
7 bill or to the committee amendment in the nature of a  
8 substitute. The previous question shall be considered as  
9 ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final pas-  
10 sage without intervening motion except one motion to re-  
11 commit with or without instructions.

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
