Mr. LINDER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2158) making appropriations for the Departments of Veterans Affairs and Housing and Urban Development, and for sundry independent agencies, commissions, corporations, and offices for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
- 3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 2158) making appropriations for
3 the Departments of Veterans Affairs and Housing and
4 Urban Development, and for sundry independent agencies,
5 commissions, corporations, and offices for the fiscal year
6 ending September 30, 1998, and for other purposes. The
7 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points of
8 order against consideration of the bill for failure to comply
9 with clause 2(l)(6) of rule XI, clause 7 of rule XXI, or
10 section 306 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 are
11 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
12 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
13 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
14 Committee on Appropriations. After general debate the
15 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
16 minute rule. Points of order against provisions in the bill
17 for failure to comply with clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are
18 waived except as follows: on page 25, line 17, through
19 page 27, line 4; beginning with “: *Provided*” on page 28,
20 line 20, through “loans” on page 29, line 11; beginning
21 with “: *Provided*” on page 48, line 3, through “program”
22 on line 7; and on page 76, line 7 through line 12. Where
23 points of order are waived against part of a paragraph,
24 points of order against a provision in another part of such
25 paragraph may be made only against such provision and

1 not against the entire paragraph. The amendments print-
2 ed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
3 this resolution may be offered only by a Member des-
4 ignated in the report and only at the appropriate point
5 in the reading of the bill, shall be considered as read, shall
6 not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to
7 a demand for division of the question in the House or in
8 the Committee of the Whole. All points of order against
9 the amendments printed in the report are waived. During
10 consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of
11 the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in rec-
12 ognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an
13 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of
14 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
15 clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be
16 considered as read. The Chairman of the Committee of
17 the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during further
18 consideration in the Committee of the Whole a request for
19 a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five
20 minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any
21 postponed question that follows another electronic vote
22 without intervening business, provided that the minimum
23 time for electronic voting on the first in any series of ques-
24 tions shall be fifteen minutes. At the conclusion of consid-
25 eration of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise

1 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
2 as may have been adopted. The previous question shall
3 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
4 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
5 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
