Mr. DREIER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1370) to reauthorize the Export-Import Bank of the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1370) to reauthorize the Export-
6 Import Bank of the United States. The first reading of
7 the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be
8 confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally

1 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
2 nority member of the Committee on Banking and Finan-
3 cial Services. After general debate the bill shall be consid-
4 ered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall
5 be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose
6 of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment
7 in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Commit-
8 tee on Banking and Financial Services now printed in the
9 bill. The committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
10 stitute shall be considered as read. Points of order against
11 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute
12 for failure to comply with clause 7 of rule XVI are waived.
13 No amendment to the committee amendment in the nature
14 of a substitute shall be in order except those printed in
15 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
16 resolution. Each amendment may be offered only in the
17 order printed in the report, may be offered only by a Mem-
18 ber designated in the report, shall be considered as read,
19 shall be debatable for the time specified in the report
20 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an
21 opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
22 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
23 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. The
24 Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may: (1) post-
25 pone until a time during further consideration in the Com-

1 mittee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any
2 amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum
3 time for electronic voting on any postponed question that
4 follows another electronic vote without intervening busi-
5 ness, provided that the minimum time for electronic voting
6 on the first in any series of questions shall be fifteen min-
7 utes. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
8 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
9 to the House with such amendments as may have been
10 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
11 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
12 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in
13 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be
14 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto
15 to final passage without intervening motion except one
16 motion to recommit with or without instructions.
