Mr. McINNIS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1127) to amend the Antiquities Act to require an Act of Congress and the concurrence of the Governor and State legislature for the establishment by the President of national monuments in excess of 5,000 acres.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1127) to amend the Antiquities Act

1 to require an Act of Congress and the concurrence of the
2 Governor and State legislature for the establishment by
3 the President of national monuments in excess of 5,000
4 acres. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.
5 General debate shall be confined to the bill and the amend-
6 ments made in order by this resolution and shall not ex-
7 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-
8 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
9 Resources. After general debate the bill shall be considered
10 for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in
11 order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of
12 amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in
13 the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee
14 on Resources now printed in the bill. The committee
15 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-
16 ered as read. No amendment to the committee amendment
17 in the nature of a substitute shall be in order except those
18 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
19 panying this resolution. Each amendment may be offered
20 only in the order printed in the report, may be offered
21 only by a Member designated in the report, shall be con-
22 sidered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified
23 in the report equally divided and controlled by the pro-
24 ponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-
25 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division

1 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the
2 Whole. The Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may:
3 (1) postpone until a time during further consideration in
4 the Committee of the Whole a request for a recorded vote
5 on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the
6 minimum time for electronic voting on any postponed
7 question that follows another electronic vote without inter-
8 vening business, provided that the minimum time for elec-
9 tronic voting on the first in any series of questions shall
10 be fifteen minutes. At the conclusion of consideration of
11 the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and re-
12 port the bill to the House with such amendments as may
13 have been adopted. Any Member may demand a separate
14 vote in the House on any amendment adopted in the Com-
15 mittee of the Whole to the bill or to the committee amend-
16 ment in the nature of a substitute. The previous question
17 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
18 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
19 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
