Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2204) to authorize appropriations for fiscal years 1998 and 1999 for the Coast Guard, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2204) to authorize appropriations  
6 for fiscal years 1998 and 1999 for the Coast Guard, and  
7 for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be

1 dispensed with. Points of order against consideration of  
2 the bill for failure to comply with section 401 of the Con-  
3 gressional Budget Act of 1974 are waived. General debate  
4 shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour  
5 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-  
6 ing minority member of the Committee on Transportation  
7 and Infrastructure. After general debate the bill shall be  
8 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. It  
9 shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the  
10 purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule the  
11 amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by  
12 the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure now  
13 printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the na-  
14 ture of a substitute shall be considered as read. Points  
15 of order against the committee amendment in the nature  
16 of a substitute for failure to comply with clause 7 of rule  
17 XVI or section 401 of the Congressional Budget Act of  
18 1974 are waived. During consideration of the bill for  
19 amendment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole  
20 may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether  
21 the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be  
22 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-  
23 ignated for that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amend-  
24 ments so printed shall be considered as read. The Chair-  
25 man of the Committee of the Whole may: (1) postpone

1 until a time during further consideration in the Committee  
2 of the Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amend-  
3 ment; and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum time  
4 for electronic voting on any postponed question that fol-  
5 lows another electronic vote without intervening business,  
6 provided that the minimum time for electronic voting on  
7 the first in any series of questions shall be fifteen minutes.  
8 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-  
9 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the  
10 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.  
11 Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House  
12 on any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole  
13 to the bill or to the committee amendment in the nature  
14 of a substitute. The previous question shall be considered  
15 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final  
16 passage without intervening motion except one motion to  
17 recommit with or without instructions.
