Mrs. MYRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2746) to amend title VI of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to give parents with low-incomes the opportunity to choose the appropriate school for their children and for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2616) to amend titles VI and X of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to improve and expand charter schools.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 2746) to  
4 amend title VI of the Elementary and Secondary Edu-  
5 cation Act of 1965 to give parents with low-incomes the  
6 opportunity to choose the appropriate school for their chil-  
7 dren. The bill shall be considered as read for amendment.  
8 The bill shall be debatable for two hours equally divided  
9 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority  
10 member of the Committee on Education and the  
11 Workforce. The previous question shall be considered as  
12 ordered on the bill to final passage without intervening  
13 motion except one motion to recommit.

14       SEC. 2. After disposition of the bill (H.R. 2746), the  
15 Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of rule XXIII, de-  
16 clare the House resolved into the Committee of the Whole  
17 House on the state of the Union for consideration of the  
18 bill (H.R. 2616) to amend titles VI and X of the Elemen-  
19 tary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to improve and  
20 expand charter schools. The first reading of the bill shall  
21 be dispensed with. General debate shall be confined to the  
22 bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-  
23 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of  
24 the Committee on Education and the Workforce. After  
25 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment

1 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider  
2 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under  
3 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-  
4 stitute recommended by the Committee on Education and  
5 the Workforce now printed in the bill. The committee  
6 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-  
7 ered as read. Before consideration of any other amend-  
8 ment it shall be in order to consider the amendment print-  
9 ed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying  
10 this resolution, if offered by Representative Goodling of  
11 Pennsylvania or his designee. That amendment shall be  
12 considered as read, shall be debatable for ten minutes  
13 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an  
14 opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall  
15 not be subject to a demand for division of the question  
16 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. If that  
17 amendment is adopted, the committee amendment in the  
18 nature of a substitute, as amended, shall be considered  
19 as the original bill for the purpose of further amendment.  
20 During consideration of the bill for further amendment,  
21 the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may accord  
22 priority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member  
23 offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the  
24 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that  
25 purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed

1 shall be considered as read. The Chairman of the Commit-  
2 tee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during  
3 further consideration in the Committee of the Whole a re-  
4 quest for a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) re-  
5 duce to five minutes the minimum time for electronic vot-  
6 ing on any postponed question that follows another elec-  
7 tronic vote without intervening business, provided that the  
8 minimum time for electronic voting on the first in any se-  
9 ries of questions shall be fifteen minutes. At the conclusion  
10 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee  
11 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such  
12 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may  
13 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment  
14 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to  
15 the amendment in the nature of a substitute made in order  
16 as original text. The previous question shall be considered  
17 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final  
18 passage without intervening motion except one motion to  
19 recommit with or without instructions.

20       SEC. 3. (a) In the engrossment of H.R. 2616, the  
21 Clerk shall—

22               (1) add the text of H.R. 2746, as passed by the  
23       House, as new matter at the end of H.R. 2616;

1           (2) conform the title of H.R. 2616 to reflect the  
2           addition of the text of H.R. 2746 to the engross-  
3           ment;

4           (3) assign appropriate designations to provi-  
5           sions within the engrossment; and

6           (4) conform provisions for short titles within  
7           the engrossment.

8           (b) Upon the addition of the text of H.R. 2746 to  
9           the engrossment of H.R. 2616, H.R. 2746 shall be laid  
10          on the table.

11          SEC. 4. House Resolution 280 is laid on the table.
