Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that programs based upon the premise that “Ebonics” is a legitimate language should not receive Federal funds.

- 1 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the House of Rep-
- 2 resentatives that no Federal funds should be used to pay
- 3 for or support any program that is based upon the premise
- 4 that “Ebonics” is a legitimate language.
