RESOLUTION

Providing for the concurrence by the House with an amendment to the Senate amendment to the House amendments to S. 562.

1 *Resolved*, That, upon the adoption of this resolution,
2 the House shall be considered to have taken from the
3 Speaker's table the bill S. 562, together with the Senate
4 amendment to the House amendment to the text of the
5 bill, and to have concurred in the Senate amendment with
6 an amendment as follows:

7 In the matter proposed to be inserted by the Senate
8 amendment, at the end of section 304 add the following
9 new subsection:

1 (c) APPLICABILITY.—This section shall apply only
2 during the period beginning on October 1, 1997, and end-
3 ing at the end of March 31, 1998.
