Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2181) to ensure the safety of witnesses and to promote notification of the interstate relocation of witnesses by States and localities engaging in that relocation, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2181) to ensure the safety of wit-

1 nesses and to promote notification of the interstate reloca-
2 tion of witnesses by States and localities engaging in that
3 relocation, and for other purposes. The first reading of
4 the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be
5 confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally
6 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
7 nority member of the Committee on the Judiciary. After
8 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
9 under the five-minute rule. The bill shall be considered
10 by title rather than by section. Each title shall be consid-
11 ered as read. During consideration of the bill for amend-
12 ment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may
13 accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether the
14 Member offering an amendment has caused it to be print-
15 ed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated
16 for that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments
17 so printed shall be considered as read. The Chairman of
18 the Committee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a
19 time during further consideration in the Committee of the
20 Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amendment;
21 and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum time for elec-
22 tronic voting on any postponed question that follows an-
23 other electronic vote without intervening business, pro-
24 vided that the minimum time for electronic voting on the
25 first in any series of questions shall be fifteen minutes.

1 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
2 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the
3 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
4 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
5 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
6 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
7 or without instructions.
