RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 78) proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States restoring religious freedom.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the joint reso-
3 lution (H.J. Res. 78) proposing an amendment to the Con-
4 stitution of the United States restoring religious freedom.
5 The joint resolution shall be considered as read for amend-
6 ment. The amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-
7 ommended by the Committee on the Judiciary now printed

1 in the joint resolution shall be considered as adopted. The
2 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
3 joint resolution, as amended, and on any further amend-
4 ment thereto to final passage without intervening motion
5 except: (1) two hours of debate on the joint resolution,
6 as amended, equally divided and controlled by the chair-
7 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
8 the Judiciary; (2) the further amendment printed in the
9 report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this reso-
10 lution, which may be offered only by the Member des-
11 ignated in the report, shall be considered as read, and
12 shall be separately debatable for one hour equally divided
13 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3)
14 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
