# RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the Senate amendments to the bill (H.R. 2709) to impose certain sanctions on foreign persons who transfer items contributing to Iran's efforts to acquire, develop, or produce ballistic missiles.

1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it  
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill  
3 (H.R. 2709) to impose certain sanctions on foreign per-  
4 sons who transfer items contributing to Iran's efforts to  
5 acquire, develop, or produce ballistic missiles, with the

1 Senate amendments thereto, and to consider in the House  
2 a single motion offered by the chairman of the Committee  
3 on International Relations or his designee that the House  
4 concur in each of the Senate amendments. The Senate  
5 amendments and the motion shall be considered as read.  
6 The motion shall be debatable for one hour equally divided  
7 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority  
8 member of the Committee on International Relations. The  
9 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the  
10 motion to final adoption without intervening motion or de-  
11 mand for division of the question.
