Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4059) making appropriations for military construction, family housing, and base realignment and closure for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

1 ation of the bill (H.R. 4059) making appropriations for
2 military construction, family housing, and base realign-
3 ment and closure for the Department of Defense for the
4 fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, and for other pur-
5 poses. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.
6 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not
7 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the
8 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee
9 on Appropriations. After general debate the bill shall be
10 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule.
11 Points of order against provisions in the bill for failure
12 to comply with clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are waived. Dur-
13 ing consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman
14 of the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in rec-
15 ognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an
16 amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of
17 the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in
18 clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be
19 considered as read. The chairman of the Committee of the
20 Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during further con-
21 sideration in the Committee of the Whole a request for
22 a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five
23 minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any
24 postponed question that follows another electronic vote
25 without intervening business, provided that the minimum

1 time for electronic voting on the first in any series of ques-
2 tions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consider-
3 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
4 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
5 as may have been adopted. The previous question shall
6 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
7 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
8 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.

9 SEC. 2. Pending the adoption by the Congress of a
10 concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year 1999,
11 the following allocations contemplated by section 302(a)
12 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 shall be consid-
13 ered as made to the Committee on Appropriations:

14 (1) New discretionary budget authority:
15 \$531,961,000,000.

16 (2) Discretionary outlays: \$562,277,000,000.

17 (3) New mandatory budget authority:
18 \$298,105,000,000.

19 (4) Mandatory outlays: \$290,858,000,000.

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
