Mr. GOSS, from the committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4103) making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 4103) making appropriations for
6 the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending Sep-

1 tember 30, 1999, and for other purposes. The first reading
2 of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points of order against
3 consideration of the bill for failure to comply with clause
4 2(l)(6) of rule XI, clause 7 of rule XXI, or section 306
5 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 are waived. Gen-
6 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-
7 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-
8 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
9 Appropriations. After general debate the bill shall be con-
10 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The
11 amendments printed in the report of the Committee on
12 Rules accompanying this resolution shall be considered as
13 adopted in the House and in the Committee of the Whole.
14 Points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended,
15 for failure to comply with clause 2 or 6 of rule XXI are
16 waived. During consideration of the bill for further amend-
17 ment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may
18 accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether the
19 Member offering an amendment has caused it to be print-
20 ed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated
21 for that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Amendments
22 so printed shall be considered as read. The Chairman of
23 the Committee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a
24 time during further consideration in the Committee of the
25 Whole a request for a recorded vote on any amendment;

1 and (2) reduce to five minutes the minimum time for elec-
2 tronic voting on any postponed question that follows an-
3 other electronic vote without intervening business, pro-
4 vided that the minimum time for electronic voting on the
5 first in any series of questions shall be 15 minutes. Con-
6 sideration of section 8106 for amendment under the five-
7 minute rule shall not exceed one hour. At the conclusion
8 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
9 shall rise and report the bill, as amended, to the House
10 with such amendments as may have been adopted. The
11 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
12 bill and amendments thereto to final passage without in-
13 tervening motion except one motion to recommit with or
14 without instructions.
