Mr. GOSS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3892) to amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to establish a program to help children and youth learn English, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3892) to amend the Elementary
6 and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to establish a pro-

1 gram to help children and youth learn English, and for
2 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-
3 pensed with. General debate shall be confined to the bill
4 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-
5 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
6 the Committee on Education and the Workforce. After
7 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
8 under the five-minute rule for a period not to exceed three
9 hours and, thereafter, as provided in section 2 of this reso-
10 lution. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill
11 for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule
12 the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended
13 by the Committee on Education and the Workforce now
14 printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the na-
15 ture of a substitute shall be considered as read. Before
16 consideration of any other amendment it shall be in order
17 to consider the amendment printed in the Congressional
18 Record and numbered 1 pursuant to clause 6 of rule
19 XXIII, if offered by Representative Riggs of California or
20 his designee. That amendment shall be considered as read,
21 be debatable for 10 minutes equally divided and controlled
22 by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject
23 to amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for
24 division of the question in the House or in the Committee
25 of the Whole. If that amendment is adopted, the provisions

1 of the amendment in the nature of a substitute as then
2 perfected shall be considered as original text for the pur-
3 pose of further amendment under the five-minute rule.
4 After disposition of the amendment numbered 1, it shall
5 be in order to consider the amendment printed in the Con-
6 gressional Record and numbered 2 pursuant to clause 6
7 of rule XXIII, if offered by Representative Riggs of Cali-
8 fornia or his designee, which shall be considered as read.
9 That amendment and all amendments thereto shall be de-
10 batable for 30 minutes equally divided and controlled by
11 the proponent and an opponent. During consideration of
12 the bill for further amendment, the Chairman of the Com-
13 mittee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on
14 the basis of whether the Member offering an amendment
15 has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congres-
16 sional Record designated for that purpose in clause 6 of
17 rule XXIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered
18 as read. The chairman of the Committee of the Whole
19 may: (1) postpone until a time during further consider-
20 ation in the Committee of the Whole a request for a re-
21 corded vote on any amendment; and (2) reduce to five
22 minutes the minimum time for electronic voting on any
23 postponed question that follows another electronic vote
24 without intervening business, provided that the minimum
25 time for electronic voting on the first in any series of ques-

1 tions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion of consider-
2 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
3 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
4 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a
5 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted
6 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the amend-
7 ment in the nature of a substitute made in order as origi-
8 nal text. The previous question shall be considered as or-
9 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
10 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
11 with or without instructions.

12 SEC. 2. After consideration of the bill for amendment
13 under the five minute rule for three hours pursuant to
14 the first section of this resolution, no further amendment
15 to the amendment in the nature of a substitute made in
16 order as original text shall be in order except those printed
17 in the portion of the Congressional Record designated for
18 that purpose in clause 6 of rule XXIII. Each further
19 amendment may be offered only by the Member who
20 caused it to be printed or a designee and shall be consid-
21 ered as read. Each further amendment and all amend-
22 ments thereto shall be debatable for 10 minutes equally
23 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent.
