# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2621) to extend trade authorities procedures with respect to reciprocal trade agreements, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 2621) to  
4 extend trade authorities procedures with respect to recip-  
5 rocal trade agreements, and for other purposes. The bill  
6 shall be considered as read for amendment. The amend-  
7 ment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the

1 Committee on Ways and Means now printed in the bill,  
2 modified by the amendments printed in the report of the  
3 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution, shall  
4 be considered as adopted. All points of order against the  
5 bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question shall  
6 be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, to final  
7 passage without intervening motion except: (1) two hours  
8 of debate on the bill, as amended, which shall be equally  
9 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-  
10 nority member of the Committee on Ways and Means; and  
11 (2) one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
