Mr. BLILEY submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the
Committee on House Oversight

RESOLUTION

Providing amounts for the expenses of the Committee on
Commerce in the One Hundred Fifth Congress.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.**

3 For the expenses of the Committee on Commerce
4 (hereinafter in this resolution referred to as the “Commit-
5 tee”), including the expenses of all staff salaries, there
6 shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House
7 of Representatives for committee salaries and expenses,
8 not more than \$14,671,538 for the One Hundred Fifth
9 Congress.

1 **SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.**

2 Of the amount specified in section 1—

3 (1) not more than \$7,179,440 shall be available
4 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
5 noon on January 3, 1997, and ending immediately
6 before noon on January 3, 1998; and

7 (2) not more than \$7,492,098 shall be available
8 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
9 noon on January 3, 1998, and ending immediately
10 before noon on January 3, 1999.

11 **SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.**

12 Payments under this resolution shall be made on
13 vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
14 Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
15 directed by the Committee on House Oversight.

16 **SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.**

17 Amounts made available under this resolution shall
18 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
19 the Committee on House Oversight.

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
