1 by fiscal year 2002 without relying on budgetary contin-  
2 gencies. The resolution shall be considered as read for  
3 amendment. The resolution shall be debatable for two  
4 hours equally divided and controlled by the chairman and  
5 ranking minority member of the Committee on the Budget  
6 or their designees. The previous question shall be consid-  
7 ered as ordered on the resolution to final adoption without  
8 intervening motion except on motion to recommit. The mo-  
9 tion to recommit may include instructions only if offered  
10 by the minority leader or a designee. If including instruc-  
11 tions, the motion to recommit shall be debatable for five  
12 minutes by its proponent and five minutes by an opponent.
