Mr. HASTINGS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 412) to approve a settlement agreement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the Oroville-Tonasket Irrigation District.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 1(b) of  
3 rule XXIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 412) to approve a settlement agree-  
6 ment between the Bureau of Reclamation and the Oroville-  
7 Tonasket Irrigation District. The first reading of the bill

1 shall be dispensed with. General debate shall be confined  
2 to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided  
3 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority  
4 member of the Committee on Resources. After general de-  
5 bate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the  
6 five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an  
7 original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-  
8 minute rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute  
9 recommended by the Committee on Resources now printed  
10 in the bill. Each section of the committee amendment in  
11 the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read. At  
12 the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment  
13 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House  
14 with such amendments as may have been adopted. Any  
15 Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any  
16 amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the  
17 bill or to the committee amendment in the nature of a  
18 substitute. The previous question shall be considered as  
19 ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final pas-  
20 sage without intervening motion except one motion to re-  
21 commit with or without instructions.
