## A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to extend the Interstate 4R discretionary program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Interstate System Im-  
5 provement Act of 1997”.

6 **SEC. 2. SET ASIDE FOR 4R PROJECTS.**

7 Section 118(c)(2)(A) of title 23, United States Code,  
8 is amended—

9 (1) in the first sentence—

1 (A) by striking “\$54,000,000” and all that  
2 follows through “1997” and inserting  
3 “\$800,000,000 for each fiscal year”; and

4 (B) by striking “any highway designated  
5 as a part of the Interstate System under section  
6 139 and”;

7 (2) by striking the second sentence; and

8 (3) in the last sentence, by striking “The re-  
9 mainder of such” and inserting “The”.
