2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT, DEVILS BACKBONE**
4 **WILDERNESS, MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOR-**
5 **EST, MISSOURI.**

6 The boundary of the Devils Backbone Wilderness es-
7 tablished by section 201(d) of Public Law 96–560 (16
8 U.S.C. 1132 note; 94 Stat. 3273) in the Mark Twain Na-

1 tional Forest, Missouri, is modified to exclude from the
2 area encompassed by the Devils Backbone Wilderness a
3 parcel of real property consisting of approximately 2 acres
4 in Ozark County, Missouri, and containing a garage, well,
5 mailbox, driveway, and other improvements, as depicted
6 on a map entitled “Devils Backbone Wilderness Boundary
7 Modification”, dated June 1996. The map shall be re-
8 tained with other Forest Service maps and legal descrip-
9 tions regarding the Devils Backbone Wilderness and shall
10 be made available for public inspection as provided in sec-
11 tion 202 of Public Law 96–560 (16 U.S.C. 1132 note;
12 94 Stat. 3274).
