Mr. MURKOWSKI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To amend the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act, regarding the Huna Totem Corporation public interest land exchange, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Huna Totem Corpora-
5 tion Land Exchange Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT OF SETTLEMENT ACT.**

7 The Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (Public
8 Law 92–203, December 18, 1971, 85 Stat. 688, 43 U.S.C.
9 1601, et seq.), as amended, is further amended by adding
10 a new section to read:

2 (2) the land to be conveyed to Huna Totem
3 Corporation and Sealaska by the Secretary of Agri-
4 culture shall be lands readily accessible to Hoonah
5 and, where possible, located on the road system to
6 Hoonah, and shall be conveyed within ninety (90)
7 days after the conveyance of lands in subsection
8 (b)(1); and are to be selected from the lands
9 depicted on the map dated and la-
10 beled attachment B.

11 “(d) **TIMBER MANUFACTURING; EXPORT RESTRIC-**
12 **TION.**—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, tim-
13 ber harvested from land conveyed to Huna Totem Cor-
14 poration under this section is not available for export as
15 unprocessed logs from Alaska, nor may Huna Totem Cor-
16 poration sell, trade, exchange, substitute, or otherwise
17 convey such timber to any person for the purpose of ex-
18 porting that timber from the State of Alaska.

1 “(e) RELATION TO OTHER REQUIREMENTS.—The
2 land conveyed to Huna Totem Corporation and Sealaska
3 Corporation under this section is, for all purposes, consid-
4 ered land conveyed under the Alaska Native Claims Settle-
5 ment Act.

6 “(f) MAPS.—The maps referred to in this section
7 shall be maintained on file in the Office of the Chief, Unit-
8 ed States Forest Service, and in the office of the Secretary
9 of the Interior, Washington, DC. The acreage cited in this
10 section is approximate, and if a discrepancy arises between
11 cited acreage and the land depicted on the specified maps,
12 the maps shall control. The maps do not constitute an at-
13 tempt by the United States to convey State or private
14 land.”
