A BILL

For the relief of Janina Altagracia Castillo-Rojas and her husband, Diogenes Patricio Rojas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 ~~Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-~~
5 ~~poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.~~
6 ~~1101 et seq.), Janina Altagracia Castillo-Rojas and her~~
7 ~~husband, Diogenes Patricio Rojas, shall be held and con-~~

1 sidered to have been lawfully admitted to the United
 2 States for permanent residence as of the date of the enact-
 3 ment of this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

4 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

5 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Janina
 6 Altagracia Castillo-Rojas and her husband, Diogenes
 7 Patricio Rojas, as provided in this Act, the Secretary of
 8 State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by the ap-
 9 propriate number during the current fiscal year the total
 10 number of immigrant visas available to natives of the
 11 country of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the
 12 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).

13 **SECTION 1. CERTIFICATE OF CITIZENSHIP.**

14 (a) *CITIZENSHIP STATUS.*—Upon the filing of an ap-
 15 plication for a certificate of citizenship and upon being ad-
 16 ministered the oath of renunciation and allegiance de-
 17 scribed in section 337(a) of the Immigration and National-
 18 ity Act, Janina Altagracia Castillo-Rojas shall be held and
 19 considered to be a citizen of the United States from birth
 20 pursuant to section 301(g) of the Immigration and Nation-
 21 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1401(g)) and shall be furnished by the
 22 Attorney General with a certificate of citizenship.

23 (b) *SUPERSEDES EXISTING LAW.*—This section super-
 24 sedes the parental physical presence requirement in section

- 1 *301(g) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.*
- 2 *1401(g)) and any other provision of law.*
